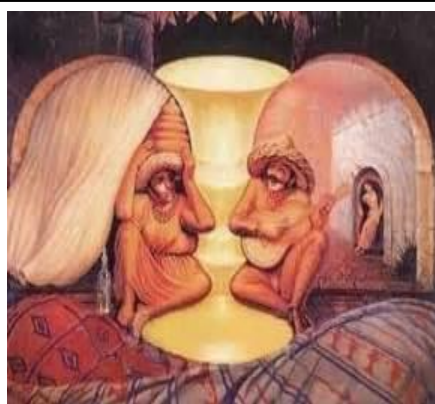
Infant Sports Day!

How many people are in the picture?

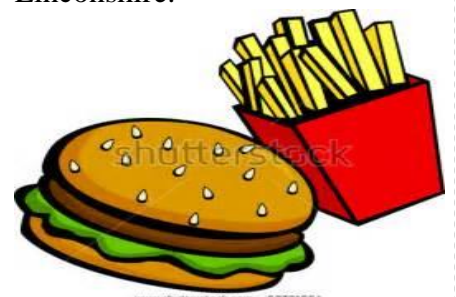
Junior Citizen Scheme!
