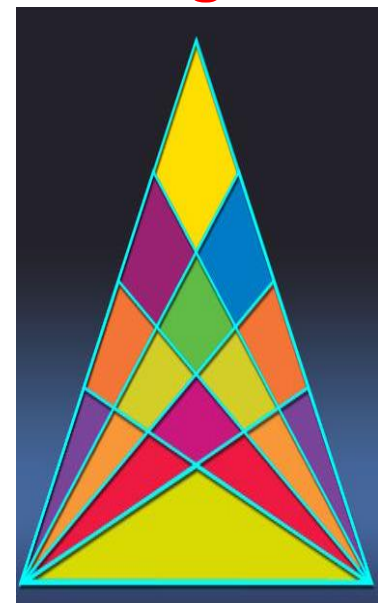


### Borough Athletics
