Novak Djokovic loses match!

World Number 2, Novak Djokovic has been knocked out of the Australian Open in the second round by Denis Istomin. Djokovic struggled to get into his stride during the match and lost the game 7-6 (10-8) 5-7 2-6 7-6 (7-5) 6-4. The fact that Istomin is ranked 117 in the world made his victory all the more surprising. Novak's defeat leaves Andy Murray, current World Number 1, as favourite to win the competition. His defeat to Istomin rounds off a difficult 7 months for Djokovic.
