Social Media Day. Will you 'Like' Me?

On the 6th March the juniors will be working with the Music Plus trust on an exciting project. The Project looks at social media and ways in which it impacts on our children and their families. Recently the Children's Commissioner highlighted the importance of helping our children learn about these issues and believes this is a key aspect of life growing up in our community today. This trust is linked to Pop UK who we have worked with before.

During the day, all the children will learn three songs, teaching them about social media and its effect on their emotions and wellbeing. They will record the three songs and hold a celebration assembly at the end of the day, where songs will be performed and they will talk about what they have learnt. This is a great opportunity for them to share with you what they have been doing at school and how social media may affect them at home too.
