Share Aware (NSPCC Online safety)

It can be hard to keep track of what your child is doing online and on social networks, apps and games and know how to keep them safe. Children under 13 years old shouldn't be using social media, but reports suggest up to 50% of younger children are regularly using these sites and apps. Just like in real life, kids need your help to stay safe. The vast majority of our junior children knew about all the social media apps and many are using them already.

Please have regular conversations about what your child is doing online, just like you would about their day at school. This is a good way to keep them safe. You will be able to spot any problems, encourage them to come to you if they are worried and make sure they know what's ok to share online and what is not.

Visit the NSPCC site and use their **Net Aware** tool and continue the conversation with your children this weekend about staying safe online and using apps.
