Safety Online

A recent Government Green paper has highlighted that

- **20% of 7-11 year olds admit they don't know how to report someone online.**
- Children fearing their parents would stop them playing online if they reported the bullying, was the main reason why they did not want to tell. Less than 50% of 8-11 year olds read terms & conditions before signing up to social media sites (Growing Up Digital - Children's Commissioner Report)

Please continue to talk to your children about being safe online and about reporting anything that concerns them. Many apps also share the location of users without the user knowing. It is important if using these apps to make sure you check whether your child's location is being shared.

Location Sharing Apps

Pokemon Raids – meeting up in one location for raids
Snapchat – maps to show the location of users.
