Our governors met this week to review their work and create a new action plan for the coming year. They gave up a morning of their time. We are fortunate to have a strong and enthusiastic governing body currently who are active around the school in many ways. Thank you for giving your time so generously.

Dental visit

This week the dentist visited our infant school to check our teeth and give fluoride treatment. Please can you encourage your children to visit the dentist regularly. The dentist saw 108 children this week and three quarters of the children seen already have decayed teeth and need urgent treatment. Many had never been to a dentist.

Our school is not unusual and reflects the national picture. Many children as young as five years old are having general anaesthetics to remove decayed teeth. 90% of tooth decay is preventable through reducing sugar consumption, regular brushing with fluoride toothpaste and routine dental visits. Fruit juice can be particularly bad! I learnt this the hard way with my own son, who also had to have a tooth out at the age of five. The fruit juices and fruit shoots were removed quickly from our house after being told off by our dentist!

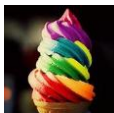
The dentists have offered to run some workshops for us!
