### Outdoor Games Lessons

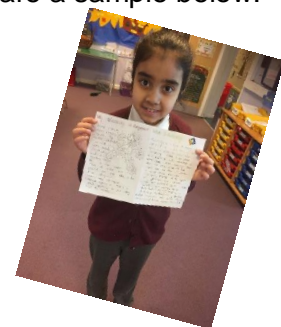
