


## Weekly Home Learning Activities Nursery - Week 7

Maths

This week we are going to try some 'washing line' maths!

The aliens enjoyed visiting washing lines and now it's your turn. If your washing dries on a washing line, you will need to help mummy or daddy this week. Maybe you can start by passing them your wet clothes or the pegs?



When the washing line is full, stand back and have a look at it, just like the aliens.

I wonder if you can use the maths words that you have been learning to talk about the clothes?

"The red shirt is the **biggest**."

"The green socks are the **smallest**."

"The blue joggers are the **longest**."

"The yellow pants are the **shortest**."

If this is easy for you, then have a go at talking about two things...

"Daddy's trousers are bigger than my trousers."

I wonder how many things are hanging on your washing line altogether?

<p>Other</p>	<p><b>Spend 20 minutes a day working on your Space project!</b></p> <p>In the focus story, we see some aliens travelling in their space ship.</p> <p>Can you build a model of their space ship? You could use recycled materials, lego or even playdough and add features such as windows and lights.</p>  <p><b>Things to consider:</b>          What shape is it?          What colour is it?          What are the windows like?          Where are the lights?</p> <p>Upload a photo of your creation to <b>Tapestry</b> for your teacher to see.</p>
<p>Creative Ideas/Wellbeing</p>	<p>Choose <u>two</u> challenges to complete each week. Make sure you upload a photo or video on <b>Tapestry</b> for your teachers to see!</p> <p><b>1. Travel time:</b></p> <p>The aliens travelled in a flying saucer, but we don't see many of those in Hounslow!</p> <p>Can you look out of a window with mummy or daddy and find out how many different vehicles you can see?</p>



You might see an ambulance, bicycle, bus, car, fire engine, lorry, motorbike, plane, van or even something else!

Maybe you can draw a picture of the vehicles you see?



If you have any toy vehicles at home, maybe you can make a collection of the ones that you saw and take a photo.



### 3. Design challenge:

Can you design a pair of underpants for the aliens to wear?



You could re-use unwanted pieces of paper or fabric, lay them on top of a real pair of underpants and take a photo to share.



Better still, if you have a spare pair of pants, why not use some pens to draw your own design?

#### 4. Skill & recycling challenge:

Now that you have been practicing your ball skills, I wonder if you can build on these by making and learning to use your own **cup and ball** game? These can be lots of fun!
