


Nursery Weekly Overview for Online Learning

<p>Ongoing Practice for EYFS</p>	<p>Reading Eggs Login details were handed out last term. Please see message on Tapestry if you need another login.</p>   <p>Name writing with a capital letter at the beginning, followed by lowercase letters, all formed correctly.</p>  <p>Makaton – watch the video on Tapestry to refresh some of the signs and play ‘What’s in the box’ with Mrs McCarthy, remembering some of the toy and fruit signs. Then sing ‘If you’re happy and you know it’ with Mrs McCarthy using the signs for the emotions; happy, sad, tired, hungry, angry.</p>
<p>Maths (Tuesday)</p>  	<p>This week we will focus on recognising numbers from 1-5. We will also be counting objects to 5. Focus: Counting and matching numbers</p> <p>Learning Intentions: I can recognise numbers from 1-5. I can count 5 objects.</p> <p>Key vocabulary: Count, counting, number names, how many?</p>  <p>Key questions: Can you point to the number 2? Can you tell me the name of this number? This is the number ... Can you give me 3 pasta pieces?</p> <p>Input: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Aq4UAss33qA Revisit numbers with the children using flash cards and showing what each number looks like on a 5 frame. On Tuesday a demonstration video will be uploaded to Tapestry.</p> <p>Task: Can you use some string and thread pasta to make your own counting equipment? Challenge: Can you have a go at writing some of the numbers 1-5 yourself on a piece of paper or board? Upload a video of you counting and saying numbers to Tapestry.</p>

Phonics (Thursday)

Key vocabulary:

Phonics, sounds, letter.

Key question:

Can you think of any words that begin with these sounds?

Input:

Listen to the jolly phonics songs for s, a and t.
