


Weekly Home Learning Activities Nursery - Week 8

Upload a photograph of all the things you found on to **Tapestry** for your teacher to see.



I wonder if you can use some new maths words as you talk about some dinosaurs?

The words are **thin** and **thick**

You may need to use these words to help you talk about the dinosaurs too:

claws, horn, neck, tail, teeth, wings.

For example, you could say:


"This dinosaur has 1 **thin** tail and 4 **thick** legs

If this is easy for you, then maybe you can compare more than one dinosaur and use some of the other words that we have been learning?

"The Diplodocus has a longer neck than the Tyrannosaurus Rex."



You could have a go at this 'Five finger breathing' activity at home and when you know what to do, you can do it anywhere!


