Planned Sports Premium Spending 21-22

In accordance with the aims and outcomes of the Action Plan, in the main, funding will be allocated to working with Sport Impact.

The aim of this will be to further develop confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport; where by sports specialists will work with teachers to plan and deliver high quality PE lessons.

One of our focuses this year will be on supporting our more complex SEND children's needs in their PE – both in small groups, and as part of their main class lessons. Sports Impact will be offering specific coaching for teaching staff in managing complex SEND needs within their lessons and planning for modification and engagement.

Funding will also extend to the same specialists working with SMSAs to ensure that lunchtime is structured and more children are participating in physical activity. Adding to this, in order to increase the engagement of pupils in regular physical activity and kick-start healthy active lifestyles, funding will also be allocated for lunchtime sports clubs across all Key Stages.

Working with Sport Impact will develop competitive sport at Wellington.

External sports coaches from Onside Coaching and DanceEnergy will run extra-curricular clubs for every year group. In these clubs, a broad range of sports and activities is offered to pupils including dance. We aim for the children at Wellington to experience a broader range of sports and activities and the curriculum map has been designed in this way, as well as to promote a progression of skills.

Funding has been allocated to the PE scheme GetSet4PE. Lesson plans within the scheme have been written with careful consideration of the aims of the National Curriculum and within these units of work, there are physical, social, emotional and thinking, whole child outcomes which progress within each year group. The scheme also offers a range of other physical activities which all teachers can access.

To ensure that all aspects of the lessons can be accessed and taught effectively, funding will also be allocated to restock various PE equipment as well as the PE clubs.
