


## Weekly Home Learning Activities Reception Week 2 – 30.3.20



Ongoing Practice	<p><b>Bug Club</b> - Read a new book on bug club! We can check how many books you have left and how many you have read so we can add more if you need. Do make sure you have clicked on every bug and answered all the questions fully. Otherwise the computer thinks you have not finished and we are not able to give you a new book.</p> <p><b>Doodle Maths</b> - Go to doodlemaths.com or use the app on a tablet. Log into your doodle account. Complete activities for 10 minutes. Your aim is to unlock '5 a day' and earn lots of stars! Make sure your parent does not help you as doodle maths will then give you really hard work for older children and you will lose interest!</p> <p><b>Summer Project.</b> Don't forget to carry on with your Under the sea project.</p>
Literacy	<p><b>The Three Little Pigs</b></p> <p>1. Listen to this story on Youtube with an adult. <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QLR2pLUsl-Y">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QLR2pLUsl-Y</a></p>  <p><b>Questions to consider:</b></p> <p>Why did the wolf try to blow the Three Little Pigs houses down?</p> <p>What did the wolf say before he blew the houses down?</p> <p>How do you think the Three Little Pigs felt when the wolf was trying to blow the house down?</p>

	<p>Which house was the strongest? Why?</p> <p>What happened at the end of the story?</p> <p>2. Make a sorry card for the Three Little Pigs from the wolf. Say sorry for blowing down their houses. Put a picture on Tapestry so we can see your lovely work!</p>
Phonics	<p>1.This week we are working on the <b>ure</b> sound.
