


Weekly Home Learning Activities Reception Week 3 – 20.4.20

<p>Ongoing Practice</p>	<p>Bug Club - Read a new book on bug club! We can check how many books you have left and how many you have read so we can add more if you need. Do make sure you have clicked on every bug and answered all the questions fully. Otherwise the computer thinks you have not finished and we are not able to give you a new book.</p> <p>Doodle Maths - Go to doodlemaths.com or use the app on a tablet. Log into your doodle account. Complete activities for 10 minutes. Your aim is to unlock '5 a day' and earn lots of stars! Make sure your parent does not help you as doodle maths will then give you really hard work for older children and you will lose interest!</p> <p>Summer Project - Don't forget to carry on with your Under the sea project.</p>

Phonics	<p>1. This week we are working on the 'ear' sound. GO to Learn with Geraldine the giraffe on https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EneZ1UubxSA</p>  <p>Write a list of ear words in sentences and upload a photo to Tapestry for your teacher to see.</p> <p>2. Learn the Phase 3 tricky word song to help you spell your tricky words: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=R087IYrRpgY</p>
Maths	<p>1. Go to doodlemaths.com or use the doodle maths app on a tablet. Log into your doodle account. Complete activities for 10 minutes. Your aim is to unlock '5 a day' and earn lots of stars! Make sure your parent does not help you as Doodle Maths will then give you really hard work for older children and you will lose interest!</p> <p>A watch will help Tiddler be on time for school. Can you use a clock or a watch to time how many jumps you can do in one minute? How many times you can write your name in one minute? How many times can you do other activities in one minute?</p>

<p>Other</p>	<p>Choose a sea creature you love. Use the internet and books to find out facts about the creature. <p>Creative Ideas/Wellbeing</p>	<p>Choose two challenges to complete each week. Make sure you upload a photo or video on Tapestry for your teacher to see!</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Cosmic Yoga with your family- cosmic yoga under the sea ! Go to https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qC83oFEeVZA to complete some yoga moves. 2. Go on an old photo hunt in your house. Ask mummy or daddy and grandparents to get out their old photos and talk about them to you. How have people changed? What was different when mummy and daddy were younger? And when grandparents were younger? Upload what you have found out on Tapestry.
