

Sport Premium at Wellington Primary School

The sport premium is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities we offer to our pupils.

Wellington receives PE and sport premium funding based on the number of pupils we have in years 1 to 6. We received funding amounting to £20,130 for the academic year of 2018 – 2019.

We have endeavoured to use our sport premium funding in a number of different ways:

- Hired qualified sports coaches to work with teachers (Simon Haughney & Paul Thomas Onside Coaching)
- Peter Whitfield - The school continues to work with Sports Impact to support the development of staff in high quality P.E provision. Peter Whitfield from Sports Impact worked with 4 Reception Teachers on Friday mornings in Spring 1. He currently works in Year 5. In these sessions, Peter supports teachers in their planning of PE using the 'Get Set 4 PE' scheme. He monitors the delivery and quality of the lesson, as well as team teaches with staff to model quality PE teaching, helping both teachers and pupils improve their skills. In Summer 1, Peter will be working with the NQTs in Year 1, now on Friday afternoons. He will then work with the Year 4 teachers in Summer 2 on Friday afternoons.
This half term, 10 children from one Year 5 Class have received some training from Peter as Sports Leaders. We had many children in Year 5 eager to become a Sports Leader so this training will continue in Summer 2 with more children across Year 5. They will be learning to lead games so that in September, they can organise games during lunchtime for Key Stage 2 children to take part in.
- This term 10 children from Year 2 (5 girls and 5 boys) took part in the Year 2 Sports Day at Cranford Community College. The year two pupils displayed tremendous determination, despite the cold weather outside and modelled excellent team work. Year 4 also took part in the inter-borough Sports day for lower Key Stage 2, also at Cranford Community College. The children took part in a range of activities, in a competitive environment, that saw them compete against over 40 schools in the borough. Year 4 reflected on their performance throughout the day, discussing skills and strategies and performed well in numerous activities.



The sport premium money that we have received has been spent according to our needs, the needs that are specific to our children. We strongly believe that the way the funding has been allocated has had and will continue to have, a direct impact on our children at Wellington.



How children & teachers have been supported:

- Reception – All 4 classes and class teachers have worked with Peter Whitfield in order to improve practice and confidence in teaching EYFS PE
- Y2 – Both class teachers were supported by Peter Whitfield in order to improve practice and confidence

- Y3 - Both class teachers were supported by Peter Whitfield in order to improve practice and confidence

Y4 - Both class teachers were supported by Peter Whitfield in order to improve practice and confidence + multi skills club held at lunchtime

Y5 – Girls can – children involved with Onside coaching at lunchtimes

Peter Whitfield has worked with Emerald class teacher and pupils to improve outcomes and confidence

Sports leaders trained by Peter Whitfield to commence work with KS2 in September 2019.

- Sports clubs – funding of places for vulnerable/in need children.

- Sport competitions – Year 3 and 4 Borough sports Day
