Children who find a tag on their bike at the end of a day can come to Miss Gaffney to choose a prize. We also regularly run a bikers breakfast. Children receive a ticket from the bike marshalls once their bike or scooter has been locked correctly in our cycle storage and scooter pods. The ticket gives them entry to the bikers breakfast. Parents and staff attend also providing they have cycled to school. The class that cycles and scoots the most during a week receives a certicate and an individual prize. Bike Marshalls set up and run the competition. Our next one is being run on week beginning: Monday 1st july 2013. (see photo evidence) Bike Marshalls complete bike maintenance training as a reward for their hard work every day during the school year: counting bikes, recording data, taking photos of the cycle & scooter storage, running competitions, attending meetings, helping out at bikers breakfasts and preparing presentations for visitors who regularly visit our school.

As a school we are working towards becoming an eco friendly school and are passionate about improving our environment. Pupils are expected to bring a water bottle to school to drink from during the day. New water fountains have been installed in both infant and junior playgrounds to incase the capcity for drinking water from 2 fountains to 6 drinking fountains. This was a school council campaign. Lessons are focused on the effects of water both on ourselves (year 1 & 2 curriculum and the environment. Geography and science KS2 objective (N.C.)Recycling is promoted for all types of materials at Wellington. School councillors are responsible for monitoring our recycling bins and how much paper we use. Paper towels have been replaced with hand dryers in all pupil and staff toilets at the school councils request. Year 3 and 4 promote reduce, reuse and recycle across the school and through our science curriculum. A year 3 assembly recently focused on 'reduce, reuse.recycle' and parents are engaged through weekly newsletters and leaflet material in the entrance area.
