If your parents want to learn about E-Safety they should come into and see Mr. Short.

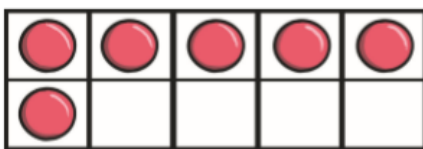
### YEAR 1
