We will keep you updated on how the seeds grew.

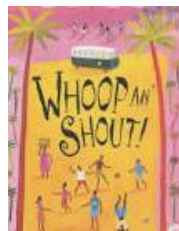

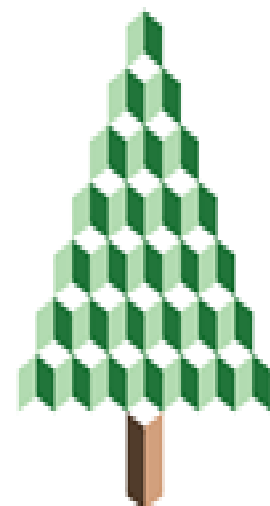
