We also had the Science Dome where we found out about lots of things. Inside the dome was amazing and dark, it was like a huge cave!

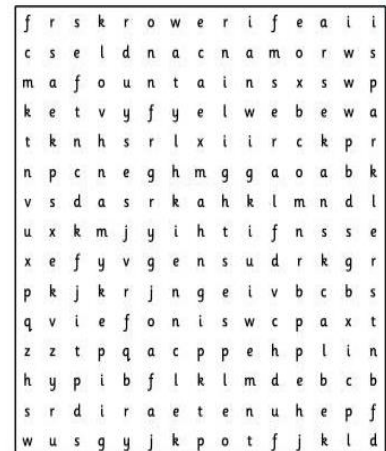
