Safer Internet Day Assembly



World news

Revolutionary new recycling method for plastic and waste is solving two problems with one system.

Carbon capturing is one of the many tools used for manufacturers, who want to do their part in combat to the climate crisis. Similarly, a startup in Israel is erasing one environmental toxin by placing it inside of another. UBC Materials is taking household waste that would normally end up in landfills, and embedding it in liquefied recycled plastic to create 'a thermoplastic', composite, bio-based, sustainable, climate-positive material. The trash is sorted, passed over a magnet to remove metals, before being dried and shredder into a kind of trash-confetti.

This is the awe-inspiring moment that a wild orangutan offered its hand to a man stuck in waters full of snakes. Since poisonous snakes are the orangutan's only real predator in the forest, it is quite likely that this particular ape knew what would happen when you are in muddy waters. The forest, which is took care of by the Borneo Orangutan Survival Foundation, is a safe place for endangered apes if they have any injuries or they are in danger.


