

# Anglo Saxons Summer Project

Year 4 are going to be learning about the Anglo-Saxons in the Autumn term. In this topic the children will learn about who the Saxons were and why they came to England, aspects of their daily life such as village life, clothing, religion, the Saxon Army, famous Saxon leaders, famous Saxon stories and the archaeological finds.



Over the summer holiday, we would like you to think about and research these key questions.

1. KQ- Where and how did the invasion of Britain take place after the Roman withdrawal?
2. KQ- How has life changed as a result of Anglo Saxon and scot invasions?
3. KQ – why were the Anglo-Saxons so smashing?

We would like you to choose one activity from each of the sub headings to complete, so you will have completed three activities. Be ready to share this in your topic lesson when we are back at school.

## What can you write about?

- Write a news report about the day the Anglo Saxon's evaded England.
- Write a diary entry in role of an Anglo Saxon warrior on their way to live in England.
- Write a short story set during the Anglo Saxon period to tell a Year 3 child.



## What knowledge can you share with us?

- Research and create a board game about Anglo Saxon life.
- Choose a famous Anglo Saxon and write a fact file about them.
- Use a thinking map to compare Anglo Saxon beliefs with your own.

## What can you make to show your learning?


- Create a model of a house.
