



These GPS tasks can be done on paper. We may also include a Reading 3 in 3, which will stimulate their reading skills. Your child may be asked to complete these on paper and take a photo, or may have to complete the task on Google. 


Orange Level - **Goldilocks and the Big Mess**




Turquoise Level - **Goldilocks and the Porridge Problem.**





