Recap the phonics taught so far and teach sound of the week Ee	Measure	BRITISH SCIENCE WEEK-MAKING FOSSILS	
Alliteration Aspect 5, activity 7- make a potion for Tricky Witch- she can only do this by putting objects that start with the same sound- b Use cauldron and objects so that they children can distinguish sounds	This week we will be using string, cubes and ribbons to measure objects. The children will be measuring dinosaurs and comparing them using key vocabulary such as short, long, shorter, longer and they will also be ordering dinosaur bones from the shortest to the longest	How do we know dinosaurs existed? Talk about this with the children and explain that scientists and paleontologists discovered fossils and dinosaur bones which taught us about them. Explain to the children what fossils are. Explain to the children that they will be making their own fossils using flour and water to make their own dinosaur print.

Session 1	Explain this week's topic of measure to the children. Show the children a variety of dinosaurs of different sizes. Using the key vocabulary cards compare and find short and tall/ long dinosaurs. Ask the children to order themselves from the shortest to the tallest	Recap the sounds taught so far. Introduce the sound of the week Ee using the Monster Phonics link below: <u>https://monsterphonic s.com/resources- lessons/reception- 5/phase-2/week- 5/monday/</u>	Making fossils Ask children if they have ever seen a real dinosaur? Explain that they no longer exist- they are extinct and we only know about them because of fossils. Ask any children if they have been to the natural history museum and seen bones? Tell the children that they are going to make their own fossils. Show the children how to do this	Monster Phonics activity Children to sit in a circle and have objects that begin with b and other sounds. Explain that Tricky Witch can only do a magic spell if the objects all begin with the same letter. Children to pick an object and say the word and recognize initial sound.	Maths Show children some dinosaur bones. Have key words short and long on the carpet. Children choose a bone and order in length
Session 2	Introduce the story of Harry and the Bucket full of Dinosaurs to the children. Talk about their favorite part of the story. 
