Literacy Maths Topic/UTW/EADD

We will be listening to the story and answering questions to see if we understand what is happening.

Did the boy really catch a star? Where are the stars?

Do you think you would be able to catch a star? What else could the boy have done to try and catch the star?

Where did the boy find the star?



Introduce the letter sound n as in night.

Children to listen and hear the sounds in the words night, necklace, nose, narwhale, number and see if they can think of any other n words. Children will have a go at air writing the letter n.

We will be looking at different shapes such as stars, triangles, circles, rectangles and square. The children will be using the shapes to make their own space pictures and seeing if they can make their own stars using the flat shapes.



This week we will have an outer space workshop to start our topic off. The children will be learning some facts about the planets through drama and songs.



We will be talking about bedtime routines and why lots of sleep is good for them.




