#### Maths

We will be focusing on matching being consistent in matching numbers to 5 with the correct quantity.

We will be having numbered containers on our walk and collecting natural objects.



We will be going for a walk around the school grounds, as well as the Nursery garden and looking at how the new buds and leaves coming on the trees. Talk about how the local area is home to many animals and minibeasts. Ask the children to keep an eye out for bumblebees, ladybirds, birds.

Session 1	Introduce the story Sam plants a sunflower to the children and the book knowledge (title, print, pictures) Read and discuss the story.  Tell the children that we are going to plant some seeds and ask the children what we need to do to make them grow.  Show the children the resources and then plant some seeds with the children and talk about how we are going to look after them.	Go for a walk around the school grounds and talk about the changes that they notice with the trees and plants. Explain that it is home for many living creatures and ask children if they can name any mini beasts.  On walk ask the children to keep an eye out for bumblebee, butterflies and other creatures they may see. Carry some pots to collect some treasures.	Maths - using the collections of treasures from yesterdays walk, show the children some numbered plant pots. Ask the children to say the numbers and then invite children up to count the correct number of objects into the numbered pot. Repeat and note the children and numbers that are still inconsistent.	Monster phonics – Rhythm and rhyme activity 8.  Using the power point of the silly rhyme to identify the rhyming words and with support to finish the rhyming captions.	Name writing and phonics.  Children to use their name cards if needed to write their name.  Encourage the children to choose a dominant hand when mark making.
