We will be talking to the children about how to negotiate conflict between themselves and a peer and how to show effortful control if they want the same dressing up outfit/toy that someone else has got. We will be reading 'The Dinosaur Department Store' and talking to the children about the print and how it carries meaning. We will be asking the children to answer some questions – some which they can see from the pictures and other that they have to really think. This week our focus is on alliteration. The children will be listening to, repeating and saying words that begin with the same sounds, we are thinking about words that begin with the same sounds. Children like thinking of words that begin with the first sound of their name. Eg. Bashir bus, brown, bed, Bella, bossy, etc.	In maths we will be using language to compare as well as counting the number of cubes tall the dinosaurs are. We will encourage the children to use words such as tallest and shortest.	British Science week – dress up. Children will be coming in to school dressed up as a Scientist. Talk about what a Scientist is and some of the work that they do. We will be looking at the Mary Anning and looking at her work with dinosaur fossils. Visit from a parent to talk about their job as a Scientist.

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
