Session 1	Introduce the story of Jaspers Beanstalk to the children. Ask the children questions throughout the story and make predictions too. Can the children retell the story and say what happened to Jaspers beanstalk on the different days of the week. Explain to the children that they will be painting Jasper/ beanstalk and write the sounds that go with the pictures they have painted i.e. j or b. Challenge can they identify any other sounds that	Children to sit in a circle. Show the children the different equipment we will be using for today's lesson i.e. spade, soil, seeds, watering can. Can the children identify and name the equipment-using labels teacher to label the equipment using the initial sound only. Show children a clip of the life cycle of a bean https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=w772PAtVTuIAdult to show the children how to plant a seed.	Math's Show children plants/beanstalks of different lengths. Explain to the children that they will be measuring the length of each one. What can we use to measure? Show children a rule and a measuring tape. Have they seen these tools before? Show they children if they can identify they longest and shortest by looking and comparing. Show the children how to use cubes to measure the beanstalks.	Phonics Recap all the sounds that we have learnt so far introduce the Rr sound. Use the action from Monster Phonics to support and reinforce the sound. Sort objects from a box which begin with r and other sounds Rock Ruby Rose Ruler Red Rectangle	Name writing and phonics. Children to use their name cards if needed to write their name. Encourage the children to choose a dominant hand when mark making. Support children in holding the pen and finding a comfortable grip. Challenge-Children to read CVC words and match to objects Bag Dog Mat Run Ant etc.



Session 2	PSHE Children to sit in a circle. Talk to the children about this terms topic. Show children images of different occupations e.g. policeman, banker, chef etc. Let the children pass Jigsaw Jennie round the circle and talk about what they would like to be when they grow up.
