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

Circle time, children speak when they have the panda otherwise they need to show good listening. | Show children flashcards numbers from 1-5. Sing Five little rockets standing in a row. Show children how to count five rockets with 1 to 1 correspondence. Introduce the number of the week 4 and ask children to come and place 4 groups of objects in a 5 frame i.e. 4 teddy bears, 4 shells, 4 counters, 4 spiders etc. | PD – Firework PE dance Children to copy the actions and movements to the song. Talk about heart rate before and after the exercise and how exercise can make you feel good. | Sing the Monster phonic S song and play the Tricky witches Super silly soup game on IWB. | Recap on the week.
