(Monster Phonics, aspect 4, activity 8)  A fox in a Miss Polly had a   We will be recapping on the sounds that we have been learning so far satpinmd and introducing the children to the new sound 'g'  Show the children a selection of objects and pictures that begin with d and see if they can hear the sound at the beginning of each word, include some with the end sound. The children will have a go at air writing the sound as well as forming the letter during mark making.	The children will continue to match objects to numerals in the indoor and outdoor environment. We will also be using ordinal numbers and relating this to the Chinese New Year story. The children will say which animal came 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc in the race.  We will be asking the children questions such as Who came 3rd in the race?  Who came last?  Can you place the animals in the correct order?  How many animals are there?	We will be discussing how people have different celebrations. Explain what celebration means and ask the children what they celebrate with their families. What do you do when you celebrate. Discuss the similarities we have when celebrating i.e. being with family, sharing special food, wearing new/special clothes etc.  Talk about the Chinese New Year and how they celebrate. Show children different foods/artifacts to explain and appreciate each other's beliefs and traditions.  -Red envelopes -Dragon -Special food - decorations




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
