Tips for helping build self-esteem

We are all so busy and it is not easy juggling family, school and jobs. Try and make time to give your child your undivided attention for at least a short time every day, listen to them and ask questions about their day.

Positive parenting is vital as it is important that your child knows that you do recognise when they have done well, have made an effort and look good which will help to improve self-esteem in children. Make a big fuss of them if they achieve a merit or a bring some special work home.

When your child feels they have failed or have been rejected try to find something good out of the experience to praise them for. This could be the amount of effort they put in, or the dedication they showed to a project. Engage with them about changes that they might be able to make in the future and what they have learned from the experience.

Take time to make sure your child knows how proud you are of them each week.
