
## World news

### Navratri

Navaratri in 2018 will started Tuesday, the 9th of October (9/10/2018) and will continue until Wednesday, the 17th of October. Navratri is a major Hindu festival in India. It is a nine nights (and ten days) Hindu festival. The dates of the festival are decided according to the lunar calendar, but it is celebrated primarily in March-April as Vasanta Navratri and in the months of September-October as Sharana Navratri. According to some Hindu texts such as the Shakta and Vaishnava Puranas, Navaratri theoretically falls twice or four times a year.

### Meghan and Harry: Duchess of Sussex expecting a baby

The announcement came as Meghan and Prince Harry arrived in Sydney on Monday ahead of a 16-day tour of Australia and New Zealand. Kensington Palace said the couple, who got married in Windsor five months ago, were "delighted to be able to share this happy news with the public". Their baby will be seventh in line to the throne. That speculation intensified when she was seen clutching two large folders in front of her stomach as she arrived in Sydney for the tour, which will also take in Fiji and Tonga. It is their first official royal tour since their wedding, which also took place at St George's Chapel, Windsor. Their first engagement was on Tuesday, when crowds of well-wishers are expected to congratulate the couple. The duke and duchess follow in the footsteps of Prince Harry's parents - Prince Charles and Diana, Princess of Wales - whose first royal tour was to Australia and New Zealand.




