### This awesome new Total Wipeout style water park has opened near west London

### Firefighters rush to scene of huge grass fire on Hounslow Heath

Four fire engines and 25 firefighters have rushed to the scene of a huge grass fire on Hounslow Heath. London Fire Brigade was called at 1.50pm on Tuesday (July 17) to reports of a large grass fire off Frampton Road, in Hounslow. One hectare of grassland is on fire - roughly the same size as a football pitch. The fire in Hounslow is the latest in a string of grass fires this month, with more than 20 firefighters called to a fire in a Hounslow allotment on Monday morning (July 16).


### Year 6 production





**Article 30** - You have the right to practice your own culture, language and religion - or any you choose. Minority and indigenous groups need special protection of this right


