### Seriously injured Indian sailor has been rescued

A seriously injured Indian sailor stranded in the middle of the Indian Ocean has been rescued. Solo yachtsman Abhilash Tomy was stranded 3,200km (2,000 miles) off the coast of Western Australia after his boat was badly damaged during a storm on Friday. He was participating in the *Golden Globe* round-the-world race. Rescue teams from various nations, including India, had raced towards Tomy, but the French fishing vessel *Osiris* reached him first. A doctor and a stretcher are on board the vessel. Tomy sent a message to race organizers saying he had a severe back injury. Now he has been taken on board an Australian navy ship on a stretcher and is being nursed.

## Year 6 visit Chertsey Museum








If you would make a robot, what will it do and why?
