
Chinese New Year




Individual and Sibling Photos



New cycle highway

It is hoped that the planned new cycle routes linking Kensington, Hammersmith and Brentford will become the first major "safe" route for West London. Transport for London has unveiled updated designs along the route originally proposed for its £70 million "CS9" Cycle Superhighway. The latest designs for the route were released for public consultation on January 30th following residents', cyclist and local councils' feedback. It comes as talks between TfL and Hammersmith and Fulham Council resolved a conflict over the route, which would see the borough get two paths, re-branded as a "cycle pathway". They would include a commuter route, and a slower path down King Street to address concerns about the loss of pedestrian pavement space. TfL strategy and network development director, Ben Plowden, said it was hoped the improved designs would get more people cycling and walking in West London.


